

QUALIFICATIONS FOR GROUP VOLUNTEERING

- 1. Groups must be members of (and in good standing with) either an Evangelical Church or an Evangelical Organization.**
- 2. Group members must have an ability to communicate their faith in Jesus Christ.**
- 3. Group members must have a genuine concern for the salvation of the souls and the spiritual welfare of Mission guests and clients.**
- 4. Groups must adhere to, agree with and sign the “Union Gospel Mission Doctrinal Statement of Faith” and the “Guidelines & Information for Groups” Policy.**
- 5. Group members must adhere to the Non-smoking and alcohol abstinence policy of the Mission while serving at the Mission.**

ACCEPTANCE AND APPOINTMENT AS A VOLUNTEER

No group may begin volunteering with Union Gospel Mission without proceeding through the proper channels. Applicants must fill out an application form, and be officially notified of acceptance.

The Mission recognizes the value of volunteers and it's dependence on them, however Union Gospel Mission is under no obligation to accept any or all volunteer applicants. Acceptance is at the sole discretion of the Mission.

GUIDELINES AND INFORMATION FOR GROUPS

BEHAVIOUR

The Mission has several different ministries with clients and people residing in some of our buildings through our recovery programs. Therefore, we appreciate when groups behave as though they were visiting in someone's home – no running, shouting etc.

Some of our residents have spent time in prison as a consequence of their addictions. Youth need to be well supervised and stay on the main floor unless accompanied by staff or working in groups.

We also request that no one has any on-going communication with our residents once they have returned to their school or church. The people in our program need to stay focused on their recovery.

The residents have their own lounge, which is their living room. In that room they can watch television, play pool and read. Please instruct your group not to enter this area.

Finally, we want to be sensitive to the feelings of our residents and also the people who come to Union Gospel Mission for food or help of any kind. Encourage your people to smile, be friendly and strike up conversations. The people who come to our mission like to be treated with courtesy, warmth and dignity, just like anyone else.

DRESS

Advise your group to dress modestly and appropriately (no low tops, bare tummies, or overly tight fitting clothing). We ask that female guests not wear short shorts or mini skirts. Walking shorts are acceptable.

SCHEDULING

We appreciate your interest in the work of Union Gospel Mission and the fact that you want to expose your group to the needs and burdens of the inner city poor. We welcome the opportunity to educate and challenge you. We will do our best to schedule you at a time that is mutually convenient for you and for Union Gospel Mission. This will be done through the Coordinator of Volunteers after you have made contact.

UNION GOSPEL MISSION - STATEMENT OF FAITH

- A. We believe the Bible to be the Divinely Inspired and only Infallible and Inerrant Word of God (2 Tim 3:16-17).
- B. We believe in the Trinity of the Deity, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, equal and coexistent from all Eternity, yet inscrutably one (1 John 5:7). We believe in the virgin birth of our Lord Jesus Christ (Matt 1:23) His Eternal Deity (1 John 1:1) and His perfect Humanity. We accept literally His miracles, His death upon the cross as the only atonement for sinners (1 Pet. 1:19) His glorious bodily resurrection and His ascension to the right hand of the Majesty on High (Rev. 1:18) and His promise to return in the air for His people and to establish His glorious Kingdom in righteousness (Heb 10:37)
- C. We believe man to be lost in his natural condition, at enmity with God and to die without Christ is to perish forever (John 8:24). We believe salvation to be through faith in Christ alone (Eph. 2:8; 3:5). We believe in the Resurrection of the saved to Life Eternal, and of the lost to Eternal Damnation (Matt. 25:46)
- D. We believe as an evangelical organization, we can work harmoniously with all those who hold the above fundamentals of the faith, and will not seek to promote personal or denominational distinctions which would be divisive to the unity of the Body of Christ as represented in the staff and Board of Directors.
