- Administer medication to residents enrolled in our Men's Recovery Program (training provided)
- Answer incoming phone calls and greet individuals at the front door, directing them to appropriate staff, services, or resources
- Monitor and help maintain the safety and security of the 320 Princess Street campus by observing and reporting unusual or concerning activity
- Provide food, clothing, and basic assistance at the door to individuals in need as resources allow
- Welcome, support, and provide direction to volunteers serving onsite
- Assist with general reception and ministry duties typical of a front-desk role within a rescue mission and recovery environment, including compassionate engagement with guests from diverse backgrounds and circumstances
