- Provide biblically based counselling support to guests from the community
- Provide supervision and occasionally preach during our weekend evening chapel services
- Supervise and direct our weekend afternoon drop-in ministry
- Complete administrative tasks as required
- Work hours will be from 12:30 PM until 8:30 PM Saturday-Sunday
